

Required Screening

Anyone attending an athletic event, must complete the self-screening COVID-19 questions. Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, must not attend the game. THERE IS NOT A FORM FOR SPECTATORS TO COMPLETE, THEY SELF SCREEN AND LET TICKET SELLER KNOW THEY ANSWERED NO TO ALL SYMPTOMS.

Event workers that are not LISD employees (ex. concessions, officials, etc.) and the media must complete the Athletic Event COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire

Social Distancing

Groups should maintain at least six feet of distance from other groups at all times.

The UIL defines a group as no more than 10 people including the members of the household and those persons who traveled together to the facility.

Fan and spectator areas including bleachers, stands, walkways, and other spectator areas should be at least six feet from team /group areas such as team benches or performance areas.

Facilities will have designated places to sit to encourage social distancing. Blue "X's" mean don't sit here. Spaces with no tape on them are spaces available to sit on.

Facial Coverings

Executive Order GA-29 regarding face coverings, applies to all UIL activities. All employees, parents, visitors and students must wear face coverings or face shields upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted and when not actively practicing or playing in the contest. Face coverings must be worn for the duration of the event.

Tickets and Seating

Due to COVID-19, a capacity limit has been implemented for UIL events this season.

Try to keep players out of bleachers before and after games

Tickets will only be available for purchase at the event site at the time of the contest. There will not be any presale of tickets.

One ticket seller, and have a gate monitor.

Bible and Monroe- We will use home and visitor side (need ticket seller for each side)

Tickets prices are \$2 for students and \$4 for adults.

Leander ISD employee badge admits employee and immediate family members in LISD facilities only.

Spectators are expected to self screen before entering the facility. Ticket sellers will ask spectators if they have answered NO to all screening questions.

Hand sanitizer will be at each ticket seller's table.

Restrooms & Water Fountains

Water fountains will not be available for use.

While all restrooms will be open, social distancing in them is encouraged and certain sinks and stalls will not be available for use.

Concession Stands

Staff, contractors, and volunteers involved in food service are required to wear face coverings as described in Executive Order GA-29.

Only prepackaged food and drinks will be sold.

Nothing that has to be touched or re-packaged

Sites should only provide condiments or flatware upon request and in single use, individually wrapped items.

Regularly clean and disinfect the food service counters and areas.

Follow proper food handling protocols.

Before each game, schools should follow the screening protocols to screen staff, contractors, and volunteers who will be involved in the food service prior to events. These individuals must also self-screen.

Athletic Event COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire

Should maintain social distances while waiting in line.

Only prepackaged food and drinks will be sold.

The number of workers should be limited.

Cash sales should be limited. If possible, use credit cards only.
Hand sanitizer must be available at concession stands.

Field/Court Access and Special Events

No fans or parents will be allowed onto the field/court at the conclusion of the game. Players will go directly to the locker room.

Field/court access will be extremely limited. Only players, coaches, and school support staff will be allowed onto the court.

Media and photographers will be limited and must be credentialed.

Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 restrictions, some special events that normally occur during a during season will be extremely limited. Head coaches and Principals will announce to their communities any special nights that will be allowed and when they will be held.

Parents will not be allowed onto courts or fields for senior nights.

We will need to work with campus principals regarding Homecoming court procedures. There will be no homecoming dances or parades this year.
